#### FRONT GATE CALL BOX

Many residents are allowing access to our community by regularly giving out our 4 Digit Codes to open the front gate. Our 4 Digit Quarterly Code should be given to family members only. All other guests should be using the **KEYPAD AT THE CALL BOX TO CALL AND BE LET IN BY OUR RESIDENTS.** For the safety of our community and its residents, the 4 Digit Code is changed quarterly but we do have a permanent code that has been established and should be **ONLY** given to FED EX, Amazon, UPS, Newspaper Carriers, Regular Housekeepers and Pool Cleaners. All others should be using the Call Box for entry. If you are unsure as to how to use the Call Box, Please email us.

- Please pick up any trash that may have made its way out of receptacles.


## **PROPERTY VALUES**

#### **MAKE NECESSARY REPAIRS TO YOUR HOME**



As residents of this beautiful community, each homeowner is responsible for caring for the exterior of their home in a way that maintains or even increases our current property values.

Generally speaking, if your home has not been painted in the last 10 years, it's probably time to do so.

- Inspect your home for damaged or rotting fascia or soffit and promptly make the necessary repairs.
- Replace broken or cracked windows.
- Repair or replace torn or damaged pool enclosures and screen entries.
- Replace or make repairs to your roof when necessary.

Per our Governing Documents, all property modifications require approval from our Architectural Control Committee, including exterior painting. Necessary forms can be found on our website under the "Forms" tab.
