From my own personal experience, rats can become an overwhelming problem if homeowners do not take the necessary precautions to prevent them from taking up residence in your attic, walls or home. Fortunately, for me, the rats were contained to just the attic. Over the past 3 months, approximately 32 rats have been trapped and removed from my attic, additional rats have died in my walls after fumigation! These rats were a combination of roof rats and sewer rats.

In working with professionals, the next step was to find the locations that the rats were entering. An inspection was performed and all possible openings in the roof and open roof vent pipes and gutter downspouts were covered with screen. Then a plumber had to be called in to perform a "smoke test" to determine if there were any open sewer vents in the walls or attic. An open sewer pipe was discovered in the wall outside of the bathroom. It was completely repaired so no more rats can enter. ALL the contaminated insulation needs to be removed, the attic will be deodorized and sanitized and new insulation will be placed in the entire attic. Believe me this has been a complete nightmare!

In order to help prevent this from happening to anyone else, here are some suggestions:

- First and foremost, contact a professional at the first sound or sight of rats in your ceilings or walls or inside your home!
- Install "chew proof screening" over all pipes and vents on the roof as well as gutter downspouts.
- Block or seal all gaps or holes, especially in the peaks of roof.
- Trim all trees that have branches that overhang roofs.
- Seal all gaps around indoor plumbing, sinks, washing machine, etc.
- Repair or block any open or broken plumbing pipes or vents in attic.

Front Gate

All gates have been repaired, are up to code and are working properly. However, at times, there seems to be an "OPERATOR" issue while using the call box to enter the community. If you enter the wrong code, you MUST be patient and wait a few seconds before trying again. If you consistently enter incorrect numbers, the electronics "jam" and the gate will not open.

Remember for security reasons, the Resident Code changes every quarter. You will find that code at the bottom of your Quarterly Bill and in the Resident Only Section of the website. Also, it is highly recommended that residents use the Call Box Directory for their guests. According to the Call Log, this is rarely happening and the codes are being consistently given out. The less people that have the codes, the more secure our community will be.



Irrigation

The Association is now using Image Irrigation for our irrigation needs. If you would like to use them for at your own expense for the area behind your fence, please contact Mike from Image directly at 561-313-9544. The cost for him to check your system is \$40.00, any repairs will be an additional charge.

Garbage Cart Placement and Holiday Pickup Schedule

Please remember to place your garbage carts at the base of your driveway(not on the grass) for pickup. Garbage carts can be place no earlier than 5pm on the day before services are rendered and must be retrieved by 5pm the following day.

For your convenience we have included the collection schedule for the upcoming holiday.

Thanksgiving Day: November 25, 2021

- Residential garbage will resume your next scheduled service day beginning November 29, 2021.
- Recycling will resume on December 02, 2021.
- Bulk/Yard and Commercial Divisions are 1 day behind regular schedule.

Christmas Day: December 25, 2021

- Residential garbage will resume your next scheduled service day beginning December 29, 2021.
- Recycling will resume on January 01, 2022
- Bulk/Yard and Commercial Divisions will resume your next scheduled service day.

New Year's Day: January 1, 2022

- Residential garbage will resume on your next scheduled service day beginning January 5, 2022.
- Recycling services are on regular schedule.
- Commercial pickups will resume on your next scheduled service day.
